PIAZZA BASILONE

The Piazza Basilone was created in November of 2003 to honor GySgt John Basilone and the "Boys That Never Came Home" from the wars in the 20th century. The Piazza stands as a permanent mark in time, celebrating the lives of the fallen and GySgt Basilone's heroism and the accolades that he received while serving this county.

GySgt John Basilone was a United States Marine Gunnery Sergeant who received the Medal of Honor for his actions at the Battle of Guadalcanal during World War II. He was the only enlisted Marine in World War II to receive both the Medal of Honor and the Navy Cross.

The Piazza is used as a gathering space for families and veterans, as well as a space for special events and more.

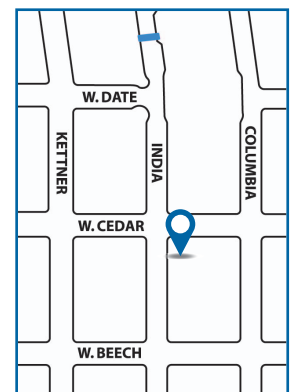
